





ADDITION TO POLICY UNDER SOLE SOURCE PROCUREMENT

- (v) *Grant Funded Approved Products and/or Vendors:* Where a granting authority is providing funding for the procurement of products and/or services and the granting agency requires that those products and/or services must be selected from an approved list of products and/or vendors at the time of application, the District may procure the approved product and/or services provided that:
 - 1. The grantor has approved the grant to the District;
 - 2. The products and/or services procured are from the grantor's approved products/services list; and
 - 3. That such procurements in excess of \$25,000 be approved by the Board of Port Commissioners






