HARBOR VILLAGE PARKING PERMITS

- Tenant & Employee Permit
 - Limited permits to encourage parking for guests and to encourage parking for employees at the Dolphin lot
- Boat Owner/Captain Permit
- Managed with pay-station system
- Revised to include 400 permits annually (Previously assumed 500 permits annually)

SPINNAKER DRIVE CONSIDERATIONS

- City staff indicated there may be ordinance changes required in order to charge on Spinnaker Drive

Multimodal improvements

Proposed locations/design of parking kiosks

Survey responses – keep free parking/lower rates

RESPONSES TO COASTAL COMMISSION COMMENTS

- Free parking on Spinnaker Drive would create congestion and impact coastal access.

- Previous surveys showed an occupancy of above 85% on Spinnaker Drive.

Different parking structure in beach lots would create higher demands

Parking plan for Ventura West Marina Lot needs to be resolved – Harbor Cove parking vs Marina Tenant parking

Port District is seeking grants for multimodal improvements

Design and implementation of paid parking program to be further refined when vendor is hired

Goal of paid parking program to increase turn-over to maximize public access

Finalize parking management plan components with the Board Coordinate with City staff to develop joint implementation strategy and ordinance changes for Spinnaker Drive Address comments and submit application to Coastal Commission staff to receive a Coastal Development Permit (CDP) Develop implementation schedule

Traffic Adjustments for Revenue Projections

- Traffic Volumes reduced for arrivals outside of 10 AM 8 PM window
- Traffic volumes reduced by 250 permits per day
